

AirServer is a computer app that will act as the receiver for devices using AirPlay.

Install AirServer on the computer that is hooked up to your projector, then use the computer to project what's on your iPad (or computer on Mavericks).

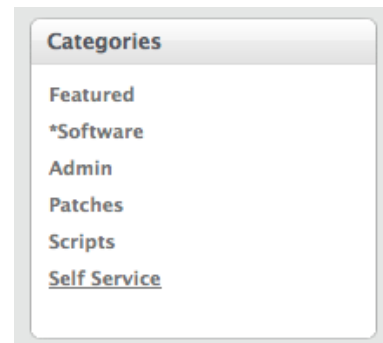
1. Go to your Applications folder, and find Self Service.
2. Log in to Self Service using your directory credentials.



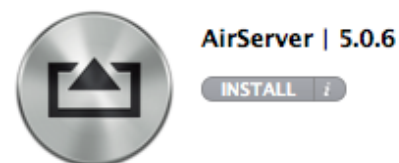

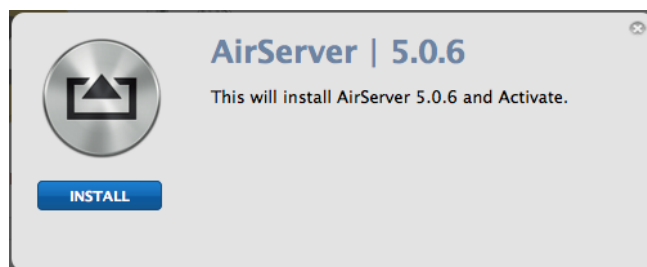
3. On the right-hand side, click on Self Service.



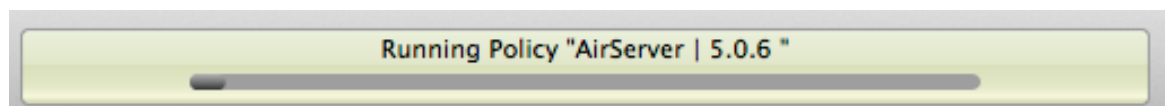
4. You'll see AirServer. Click INSTALL.



5. You will see a dialog box with an INSTALL button. Click install.

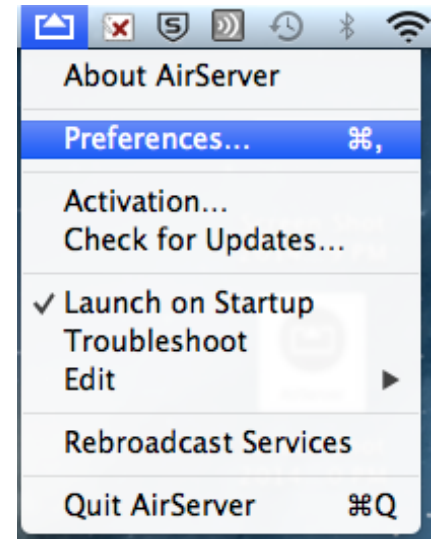


6. You'll see the progress of the installation.



The first time you use AirServer, you'll need to launch it from your Applications folder and do a little setup. Once it's been launched the first time, it'll launch automatically subsequent times on that computer and you won't have to do anything else.

1. Launch AirServer from your Applications folder.
2. In the top, right-hand side of your menu bar, you'll see a square with a triangle AT THE TOP of the icon. That's AirServer.
3. Click on the icon, then select Preferences...



4. Change No Password to Fixed Password.
5. Type a simple password in the box... Maybe your room number.
6. NOTE - You can change the Computer Name if you want to make it easier to find.
